



Rules of Participation



PLAYERS MUST READ AND ADHERE TO THE FOLLOWING RULES

Players may be removed from games for breaching any of the following:

CONDUCT

- Referee decision is final and not to be disputed.
- No Paintball marker may be discharged or taken into any “safe” area.
- Players must ensure barrel-blocking devices as provided must be engaged and safety switches on while not actively participating in a game.
- Players must wear goggles/safety equipment at all times. Removing them only when instructed by the referees.
- Players must strictly observe all safety signage and referee instructions.
- Participants and visitors must not be under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Participants and visitors displaying unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive or violent behaviour will not be tolerated and will be asked to leave the premises.
- No dangerous objects including, cigarettes, lighters or matches are permitted on the playing fields.

GAMES

- Eliminated players – when tagged by a paintball, raise your marker, arm or both in the air above your head. Engage the barrel-blocking device, switch on the safety and quickly move out of the playing area. Follow referees instructions. **DO NOT REMOVE YOUR GOGGLES.**
- During games players must remain within designated games (playing field) areas.
- Players must not fire upon another person under a distance of 3 metres.
- Do not destroy flora or fauna and do not fire at any wildlife.
- Players are not permitted to climb props and all props must remain on the ground at all times.
- All injuries are to be reported to a referee.

EQUIPMENT

- Do not disengage any safety features of the equipment unless instructed by a referee.
- Please respect the equipment you have hired from us. **YOU WILL BE liable for all damages to your equipment.**
- **DO NOT REMOVE GOGGLES OR SAFETY EYE WEAR FOR ANY REASON UNLESS INSTRUCTED BY REFEREE.**

POTENTIAL HAZARDS OR INDOOR AND OUTDOOR GAMES AT SPLAT ZONE

- Observing these simple safety rules will ensure you have a fun and safe experience. Participants who do not adhere to our safety rules may cause injury on themselves or others around them.
- As our games are in an indoor/outdoor environment, there are many potential hazards including bug and animal bites, grasses, thistles and thorns, trip hazards such as exposed rocks, ground depressions, undulating ground, fallen timber, exposed tree roots and tree limbs, mud and gravel, tree stumps, eye hazards include tree branches, sticks and dust, and other environmental issues.
